## WHAT IS SUMMER 3D ?

SUMMA3D is a 3D animation contest which goals are: (1) supporting the talent; (2) assisting production companies in their search of qualified and specialized professionals; (3) introducing to the market new talent at every level of the production spectrum; (4) fostering this new talent and (5) promoting new projects to produce.

## STARTING DATE

The contest officially starts on March 1st, 2017.

## CANDIDATES

Any natural person who is at least 18 years old, or any legal entity, both of them owners of the corresponding IP rights can participate in the contest. They must also be owners of the exclusive rights to license such material.

## RULES AND CONDITIONS

By participating in this content you willingly accept the rules and conditions hereby stated. Any circumstance that is not being mentioned in this document, will be resolved by the SUMMA3D jury members.

## REGISTRATION PROCESS

If you wish to participate in SUMMA3D you need to access [www.summa3d.com](http://www.summa3d.com) and in the Registration section, after reading the Terms & Conditions also available in the site, click on the “Registration form” link. Then you will be redirected to the registration form, once filled in you must send it us via email to [inscription@summa3d.com](mailto:inscription@summa3d.com). In here you must enter the requested data and select the category you want to participate in (if you want to participate in more than one category you must then fill another registration form). All information and works must send through **wetransfer** to [works@summa3d.com](mailto:works@summa3d.com)

The works of the category " finished short 2017" can be also registered and sent through [www.festhome.com](http://www.festhome.com) filling in all the required sections.

- **Category A: “3D short-film project”**

Category description:

SUMMA3D contest category for producers, directors and writers who are part of the development of an animated short-film which, regardless of still being in progress, can be evaluated as a whole project: artistically, structurally and financially.

- **Categoría B “Finished 3D short-film in 2016”**

Category description:

SUMMA3D contest category for producers, directors and writers who have finished the development of an animated short-film throughout 2016. This one will be evaluated at a project level: artistically, structurally and financially.

- **Categoría C: “Character design”**

Category description:

SUMMA3D contest category for those artists capable of designing an animated character both in 2D and 3D. Such character should have the potential of becoming the protagonist of a story. The submission deadline is the same as for the remaining categories.

- **Category D:** “Best 3D architectural infographics”

Category description:

SUMMA3D contest category for those students and professionals in 3D infographic architectural projects, which will be evaluated in both artistic and technical fields.

- **Category E:** Public prize to “The best short-film of 3D animation”

Category description:

SUMMA3D contest category for those candidates in Category C, whose will be evaluated by the attending public to the screening of all short films selected by the SUMMA3D's APP.

- **Category A: “Proyecto de corto”**
  - Certificate which credits the applicant as the owner of all graphic designs, drawings and creations included in the project
  - Teaser (optional)
  - Finished script and fully developed storyboard
  - Synopsis
  - Action/working plan
  - Closing credits
  - Budget
  - Budget summary sheet
  - Financial plan
  
- **Category B: “Character design”**
  - 2D designs
  - Character development in 3D (optional )

Both design and personality of the character will be evaluated: i.e. the visual aspect and the story behind the visual aspect. It is imperative to show the character in a situation that reflects his personality instead of presenting it in a 3D turn-around.

- **Category C: “Finished 3D short-film in 2016”**
  - Finished short-film, with a running time of no more than 60 minutes. The resolution must be 1920x1080 Full HD).
  - Report/statement signed by the production co., the writer/s and the short-film director.
  - Certificate which credits the applicant as the owner of all graphic designs, drawings and creations included in the project.
  - Synopsis
  - Closing credits

- **Categoría D: “Best 3D architectural infographics”**
  - Certificate which credits the applicant as the owner of all graphic designs, drawings and creations included in the visualization project or teaser (optional)
  - Finished script and fully developed storyboard
  
- **Category E: Public prize to “The best short-film of 3D animation”**
  - Finished short-film, with a running time of no more than 60 minutes. The resolution must be 1920x1080 Full HD).
  - Certificate which credits the applicant as the owner of all graphic designs, drawings and creations included in the short-film.
  - Closing credits

The deadline for submission of all material is **August 31 2017**

## JURY

- The jury for all categories in this contest will be composed of both national and international professionals, widely recognized in the 3D production and animation sector.
- Candidates and all submitted material will be subject to the jury's unappealable verdict

## CONTENT SCREENING / PUBLICATION

Participants expressly authorize to SUMMA3D organization full or partial screening and showing of their work/s in order to meet all non-profit promotional purposes. The organization is only authorized in the case of television and internet media to the use of extracts from the film. In no case of the complete film.

## PERSONAL DATA AND LOPD

The compilation and processing of personal data is destined to properly manage the contestants' application process, as well as to allow for the delivery of information related to the contest and other activities which the organizer might develop in the future.

Participants authorize all sponsors to include their personal data in all official communications related to the contest, as well as to use and process, automatically or not, these data in order to manage all operations derived from the contest.

The organization commits itself to treat personal data, and demands the treatment of all stored personal data, according to Article 12 of the Spanish Constitutional Law 15/1999, related to the Personal Data Protection Act.(LOPD).
